# SYNOPSIS



*Stage Door* is a 1936 play co-written by George S. Kaufman and Edna Ferber. It is the story of a struggling young actress living in New York City and the girls who occupy the boarding house in which she is staying.

This is NOT one of the typical plays that a high school drama club would attempt. But it is a perfect fit for the ROHS Drama Club. It features a large cast with some very challenging roles.

For those of you not familiar with *Stage Door*, it was co-written by the legendary George Kaufman (also wrote *You Can't Take It with You*, *The Man Who Came to Dinner* and *Once in a Lifetime*). It's about a group of young girls who have come to New York in the 1930s to study acting and find jobs. The action takes place in Mrs. Orcutt's boarding house, where the hopes and ambitions of 16 young women are revealed.

We follow the courageous Terry Randall, who fights against discouragement to a position in the theater where we are sure she will conquer. One of her fellow aspirants gives up in despair, one gets married, and one goes into pictures, but Terry, with the help of idealistic David Kingsley, sticks to her guns.

## Hall of Fame

I hear that there's going to be a new Hall of Fame put up in this school. There used to be one, back when I attended here in the '70s. Big framed photos of athletes up and down the Glass Hall. In those days being a star in music or drama or band or art or journalism or science was not considered letter-worthy. It sure didn't get you a framed photo on the wall. But I'm told that this new Hall of Fame will not be limited to sports. Sometimes, times change for the better.

In *Stage Door*, young independent and creative women search for their own Hall of Fame in 1930s New York City. They face many of the same problems that creative people still face today. The same way that today's students face the challenges their parents went through

They love success. They are learning to lead, to cooperate, to be part of a winning team. And they are all earning it, together.
